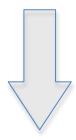

## FDCW'S 16G TRAINING PATHWAY TO BECOME AN ACCREDITED LEVEL 1 FACILITATOR

Level 1	Building on the Basics (BOB) or	Level 2	Level 3
Certification	"Equivalent" Certification	Certificaton	Certification
Full participation in Level 1 workshop with 12 instruction hours,  Complete Level 1 online survey.	Full participation in 20 hours (12 hours group work + 8 hours self study).  + Participation in BoBsmall-scale community project + Helptoorganise the project report or video.  If group participation not available, complete BoB as self-study + submit journal of experience and completed BoB course materials.	Minimum 6 months integration of 16G before participating in a Level 2.  Full participation in Level 2 workshop with 12 instruction hours.  Complete Level 2 online survey.	Minimum 6 months integration in between taking Level 2 and Level 3.  Full participation in Level 3 training with 16 instruction hours and interview with Level 3 trainer.  Fulfil recommendations from Level 3 trainer  Attend a meditation retreat (Mindfulness, silent meditation, etc. minimum 5 days).  Co-facilitate a Level 1 workshop.  Be approved as an accredited Level 1 trainer by FDCW.  Sign Accredited Facilitator's agreement & Ethical Policy.

## Based on your commitment to aim:

- to embody the 16G in your daily life
- to cultivate a daily mindfulness practice
- to explore contemporary understandings of neuroscience, mindfulness, Buddhist and Western psychology
- to contribute to the 16G community
